creatures as) before or after or behind them. Nor shall they compass nothing of His knowledge except as He Wills. His throne does extend over the heavens and the earth, and he feels no fatigue in guarding and preserving them for He is the Most High, the Supreme (in glory). Let there be no compulsion in religion: Truth stands out clear from error: Whoever rejects evil and believes in Allah has grasped the most trustworthy handhold that never breaks. We begin the day on the natural way of Islam and statement of sincerity and on the deen of our prophet Muhammad (SAW) and on the path trodden by our father, Ibraheem (AS) the monotheist who was never among the polytheists.
